Accordingly, sealed tenders affixed with revenue stamp worth Rs.10/- are invited from reputed Decorators / Contractors registered with any Government / Trade Fair Authority for providing various items for stalls, illumination, Gate, display (interior and exterior) and maintenance as per specification details given in the tender document which can be collected in person from the office of Joint Director Handloom Development Department, 96-Rajbagh, Srinagar, against payment of Rs. 500/- during working hours on any working day or from the Office of Assistant Director, Handloom, White House, Magarmalbag, Srinagar. It can also be downloaded from the Departmental website www.jkhandloomdepartment.org.

The last date and time for submission of tenders is 28.08.2014 upto 1 pm and shall be opened on the same day i.e. 28.08.2014 at 2 pm, in presence of the tenderers who may wish to remain present. The tenders should be accompanied with CDR of Rs.25000/- pledged to Joint Director Handloom Development Department, 96-Rajbagh, Srinagar, without which no tender will be accepted. SCHEDULE A.

Details of General /Standard Specification for the Interior and Exterior Decoration work in National Handloom Expo at Srinagar.

Theme Pavilion in National Handloom Expo 2014, area of Theme Pavilion is 700 to 800 sq.ft and construction of Theme Pavilion shall be as under:-

- The Theme Pavilion is to be constructed at 2 feet above from the ground level and height of Pavilion 14feet.
- It should have two gates one as entrance gate and other as exit gate. The width of the gate should 4 feet.
- The gate have stair.
- (Flex Banner 4 Feet x 8 Feet) mentioning Development Commissioner for Handloom's, Ministry of Textile, Govt. of India, and Weaver's Service Centre, Srinagar along with the flower's pot are displayed between both of the Gates.
- Dark Grey color carpet for whole Theme Pavilion.
- The walls of Theme Pavilion should be covered with white cloth/colored.
- Spot light 20 Nos.
- Iron stands 10 Nos. size 4x6 feet for fabric/cloth and shawl display.
- 10 Nos. of Mane queen (female).
- Podium made of ply wood 10 Nos. Size 1 x 1 x 1
- LCD with stand along with complete set.
- Tea Table 2 Nos. / Chair 4 Nos.

Tenderers are advised to visit the venue before quoting bids.

Stalls: There are permanent stalls available at the venue site. The contractor shall have to Provide following items in each stall.

Racks:- Two steel Racks to be kept on the back wall of the stall. The height of the racks should commensurate with size of the wall. Tenderers may visit the site before quoting bids.

Stackable chair:- Two for each stall. These shall be of collapsible in tubular frame of 12mm diameter with padded canvas back and seat. All steel material shall be powder coated and the seat and back shall be matching color.

Carpet:- Shall be in a color as approved by the exhibition authority in Unitex or equivalent brand with no stains cur or tear. All rolls shall be glued or taped to the floor during the entire exhibition. It shall cover the entire floor area of the Stall.

Dustbin:- One Dustbin of White/Black color in opaque plastic for each stall.

Specifications for Camp Office:

Center Table: - Good Quality center table shall be with glass top brown tinted in color with ten chairs.

Sofa: - Two Sofa's with arms. Backrest and seats shall be cushioned.

Entire floor area of the camp office shall be carpeted. It shall be in a color as approved by the exhibition authority in Unitex or equivalent brand with no stains cut or tear. All rolls shall be glued or taped to the floor during the entire exhibition.

Public Announcement system:-

Complete Public announcement address system with powerful (P-A-60 switch over type amplifier with 2 microphones with tape players and 15 numbers loudspeakers strategically placed up to the grounds and parking area. The contractor to operate the sound system and play cassettes of recorded music and messages of the choice of the Expo authority shall provide a full time operator. The control, amplifier etc shall be located in the room/space to the approval of authority.

Electrical Fittings (General Illumination):-

All fittings shall be focused to ensure general illumination as well as to highlight display and decoration.

Tube lights:-

Complete with choke, starter,60 watt tube and all other fittings for stalls as well for Ground.

Spot light:-

With incandescent reflector bulbs and black or white powder coated luminaries. As per requirement the fixing detail shall be clamp type, screw able or concealed.

Metal Halides:-

Shall be 1000,500 watt with powder coated waterproof body able to withstand exposure.

V.I.P Lounge:-

Shall have carpeting and shall have VIP Chairs & tables as per the instructions/directions of the Exhibition Authority/officer nominated by Exhibition Authority. It shall have a backdrop in flex with design/concept approved by the exhibition authority. It shall be well decorated with marigold flowers for the inaugural day and the concluding day, one podium to be provided along with completes public address system and dice.

GENERAL REMARKS AND CONDITIONS.

- Sealed tenders affixed with revenue stamp worth Rs.10/- are invited from reputed Decorators/Contractors registered with any Government/Trade Fair Authority for providing of various items in stalls, illumination, Gate, display (interior and exterior) and maintenance as per specification for the National Expo to be held with effect from 22.08.2014 at Kashmir Haat.
- The duration of the exhibition shall be 15 days. However, in case it is extended up to three days, no extra payment shall be made to the contractor. In case the Exhibition is extended for more than three (3) days, extra payment for each extended days(s), beyond 17 days shall be made at the rate not exceeding proportionate cost for 17 days. On completion of the Expo, the contractor shall have to take away all materials within 24 hours from the completion of the Expo and shall have to vacate the site. They will be liable to pay actual rent of the exhibition premises besides the penalty for the period if occupy site beyond the stipulated time permitted free of cost to them for vacating the site. Thereafter, the contractor shall remove from the premises and deemed to be in unauthorized occupation as a trespasser.
- The Exhibition Authority shall formally make the exhibition site available to the contractor one week before the inaugural day. Tenderers are advised to inspect the site for physical analysis before tendering and are expected to have been satisfied about its condition. The tenderer shall have to ready two days before the inauguration date and any delay or laxity shall be liable for penalty by the Expo authority. The progress of the work shall be checked and supervised by the Exhibition Authority to ensure that the work is done as per specifications and time schedule.
- The tenderer should fill the rates tendered in figures as well as in words. The tender form may be filled in English and all entries made by hand and written in ink. Over writing in rates is not permitted. All corrections occurring on each page of the tender form and other related papers submitted therewith should be signed by the tenderer. Rates should be quoted item wise as shown in schedule and all applicable taxes and duties levied by government should be clearly mentioned by tenderer separately.
- Tenderer is required to deposit an earnest money of Rs. 25000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand). The amount of earnest money will be accepted only in the form Demand Draft or FDR drawn in favour of the JOINT DIRECTOR, HANDLOOM DEVELOPMENT, J&K payable at Srinagar. The tenders of the contractors who do not deposit earnest money in the specified manner will similarly be rejected. No earnest money shall be released before the inaugural function of Expo in case of failed tenderers.

- While submitting the tender, the tenderer should submit the following:-
- Proof of satisfactory completion of works of similar nature executed giving details of their magnitude, cost and time in which the works were completed.
- Proof of financial status and credit worthiness of the firm.
- Earnest money.
- Copy of the requisite registration certificate.
- Any tender not accompanied by requisite documents motioned above or received after stipulated date and time shall not be liable to be considered and shall be summarily rejected.
- Exhibition Authority reserves the right not to accept the lowest tender the right to reject any or all tenders or portion of the tender and award the remaining work to any other contractor with assigning any reason. Conditional tender in any form whatsoever shall be liable to outright rejection. Unsealed tenders shall be summarily rejected.
- Tender shall be submitted on or before 28th August 2014 till 1 pm. And the same will be opened on the same day at 2.00 pm. In presence of the tenderers if they wish to be present.
- The successful tenderer shall immediately and not later than the next working day of intimation of acceptance of tender, sign an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value. Failure to do so shall give the Exhibition Authority the right to revoke the acceptance of the tender without further notice to the tenderer, forfeit the Earnest money deposit and award the work to any other contractor. The contractor shall be black listed and also black listing of the firm with all sister organization shall be recommended.
- The Earnest money of successful tenderer will be retained as security for successful completion of the contract and shall be returned only after Exhibition is over and the exhibition Ground at Kashmir Haat is handed back to the authorities in the restored condition within the stipulated time.
- In case any portion of work is not completed as per laid down specifications and handed over the Exhibition authorities on the due date/time as specified in the work order agreement ,penalty up to 10% of the balance work which was to be completed within the time stipulated in the work order /agreement will be levied.
- The volume and number of the works may vary at the discretion of the Exhibition authority up to 30% of the contracted work. The final payment to the contactor shall be regulated on the basis of actual work executed and on the rate(s) approved. For works outside the work order, contractor will have to quote rates separately. For all such works the Exhibition Authority reserves the right to pay the lowest of the rates quoted by the competing contractors or on the basis of assessment of reasonable market rates.
- The contractor will be responsible for upkeep and maintenance of the entire work done by him during the exhibition. In addition, the contractor is also liable for doing such works to restore and hand over the exhibition Ground at Srinagar, J&K to the authorities at his own cost, after the completion of the Exhibition, not later than the stipulated time/day mentioned above .He shall have to ensure adequate number of sweepers/cleaners shall report to Exhibition authority. Daily breakage and damages in any work shall immediately be reported and restored in the original shape; no extra payment will be made, on account of any reasons whatsoever.

- No part of the contract will be sub-let by the successful tenderer with proper written permission of the Exhibition Authority.
- It shall be the responsibility of contractor to obtain requisite permission for water, electricity and other essential connections at the Exhibition premises for the duration of the exhibition i.e. from the date/time the exhibition Ground at Kashmir Haat, Srinagar is handed over to the contractor for construction till the date/time it is handed back to the J&K Handicrafts Department from whom it has been taken for the said use. The Exhibition authority shall pay consumption charges for electricity for the duration of the Exhibition and also shall pay the expenses of obtaining connection.
- In regard to electrical fitting etc., the contractor shall be to engage a qualified licensed electrical contractor entitled to erect handle and maintain high-tension supply line and its upkeep and maintenance.
- The contractor shall not use any materials other than those specified in tender without the prior permission of the Exhibition Authority.
- Out of the 50% funds received from the Development Commissioner, Handlooms Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India, under the component infrastructure, part payment may be made to the contractor according to the progress of the work as set out in the agreement at the discretion of the exhibition authority whose decision shall be final. Rest of the payment out of the funds already received will be made only after completion of satisfactory work. Rest 50% shall be paid after funds are received from the Govt. of India.
- The contractor's responsibility for the contract shall commence from the date of issue of orders of acceptance of tender.
- The rates for all items of work shall, unless clearly specified otherwise, include cost of all labour, inclusive of all taxes.
- The Exhibition Authority reserves the right to alter any specification/details/finishes of the material/design at any time, and the contractor shall have to abide by the decision of the exhibition authority.
- The rates of all items of work must include cost of all labour, transportation, octopi and all types of taxes
- Food court shall be provided by the tenderer on his own without any payment by the exhibition authority.
- Additions/alterations, if found necessary at any stage shall be executed by the tenderer
- Payment for the theme pavilion shall be made by the Weavers Service Centre, Srinagar.
- Remittance charges on payment to the firms shall be borne by the offered.
- The department is not responsible for any damage, or theft of any article due to any cause whatsoever at the venue site or during transportation.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- The 'contract' means the documents forming the tender and accepts formal agreement.
- Executed between the exhibition authority and the contractor together with the documents referred to therein including these conditions the specifications, designs drawings and instructions, issued from time to time by the Exhibition Authority and all these documents taken together shall be complimentary to one another.
- In the contract the following expressions shall mean, unless the context otherwise require have meanings, hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - The expression work shall, unless there be something either in the subject or context repugnant to such construction be constructed or taken to mean the works by or by virtue of the contract contracted to be executed whether temporary or permanent and whether original, altered substituted or additional.
 - The expression work shall, unless there be something either in the subject or context repugnant to such construction be constructed or taken to mean the works by or by virtue of the contract contracted to be executed whether temporary or permanent and whether original, altered substituted or additional.
 - The site shall mean the land /or other places on into or through which work is to be executed under the contract or any adjacent land, path or street which may ,be allotted or used for the purpose of carrying out the contract.
 - The contractor shall mean the individual or firm or company, whether incorporated or not, undertaking the works and shall include the legal personal representative or such individual or the persons composing such individual or the persons composing such firm or company and the permitted assignees of such individual or firm or company.
 - The exhibition authority means the Joint Director Handloom Development Department

Clause 1: Duration of Exhibition/Handing over the site.

The duration of the Exhibition shall be 15 days however, in case it is extended by three days, no extra payment shall be made to the contractor. In case the Exhibition is extended for more than three days, extra payment for each extended day(s) beyond 18 days shall be made at the rate not exceeding proportionate cost for 18 days. On completion of the Exhibition, the contractor shall have to take away all materials within a period to be stipulated by the Exhibition authority at the time of awarding the tender and shall have to vacate the site. He shall pay actual rent of the Exhibition Ground at Srinagar Haati.e Rs.15,000.00 per day plus 30% of actual rent as penalty per day for the extra days he occupies the Exhibition site beyond the stipulated time permitted free of cost to him for vacating the site. There after the contractor shall be removed from the premises and deemed to be in unauthorized occupation as a trespasser. The contractor shall handover the Exhibition Site back to the Exhibition Authority in the resorted condition as the time when it was handed over to the contractor.

Clause 2: Schedule of time:

The entire work should be completed by one day before inaugural day.

Clause 3: Termination of contract:

In case the contractor fails to complete the work according to the specification and/or fails to maintain the assigned work to the satisfaction of the committee nominated by the Exhibition authority, the Exhibition authority shall be entitled to recover 10% of the contractual value of the work per day subject to a maximum of 3 days. And the Exhibition authority has the right to cancel the contract and deduct the sum from the payment if any due.

The Exhibition authority shall be entitled to cancel the contract, if it is found that there has been any breach of the conditions of this contract and/or the work is found to be unsatisfactory. The contractor in such cases will not be entitled for making any claim, compensation or any monies, the Exhibition authority is entitled to forfeit the Earnest money and the contractor may not be considered for award of any similar contracts in future.

Clause 4: Completion of work:

The contractor shall complete the entire work within the time schedule as per specifications and the satisfaction of the exhibition Authority or the nominated officer by the Exhibition authority and handover to the Exhibition authority at 09.00 am on the inaugural.

Clause 5: Payment terms:

Out of the 50% funds received from the Development Commissioner, Handlooms Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India under the component infrastructure, part payment may be made to the contractor according to the progress of the work as set out in the agreement at the discretion of exhibition authority whose decision shall be final. Rest of the payment out of the funds already received will be made only after completion of satisfactory work. Rest 50% shall be paid after funds are received from the Govt. of India.

Clause 6: Works to be open to Inspection:

The progress of the work will be checked and supervised by the Exhibition authority or by the officer duly nominated by the exhibition authority, at all times.

Clause 7: Contractor to be liable for bad work:

The contractor shall be liable for damage if found that the work has not been carried out as per the specifications. The decision of the Exhibition authority or the officer duly nominated by the exhibition authority regarding this shall be final.

Clause 8: Variation in work:

The volume and number of works may vary either way at the discretion of the Exhibition authority up to 30% of the contracted work. The contractor will be given three days' notice of such variation. The final payment to the contractor shall be made on the basis of actual work executed and on the rate(s) approved. For works outside the work order, contractor will have to quote rates separately. For all such works the exhibition authority reserves the right to pay the lowest of the rates quoted by the competing contractors or on the basis of assessment of reasonable market rates.

Clause 9: Withdrawing and lien in respect of sum claimed:

Whenever any claim or claims for payment of a sum of money arises out of or under the contract against the contractor, the exhibition authority shall be entitled to withhold and also have a lien retain to such sum or sums in whole or in any part from the Earnest money deposited by the contractor for the purpose and same pending finalization or adjudication of any such claim. In the event of the security being insufficient to cover the claim amount or amounts, the Exhibition authority shall be entitled to withhold or have a lien to retain any such sums found payable pending finalization of such claims.

Clause 10: Maintenance:

The contractor will be responsible for upkeep and maintenance of the entire work done by him during the exhibition. In addition, contractor is also liable for doing such works to restore and hand over the exhibition site to the exhibition authority at his own cost after the closer of exhibition not later than the stipulated days mentioned above. He shall have to ensure adequate number of sweepers/cleaners to the satisfaction of the exhibition authority and these sweepers/cleaners shall report to Exhibition authority daily at the fixed time. Breakages and damages in any work shall immediately be repaired and no extra payment will be made, on account of any reasons whatsoever

Clause 11: Observation of Labour Laws:

The contractor is responsible for observing all the relevant labour laws in force during the execution of the contract. The contractor shall be responsible and liable during the execution of the contract and through the Exhibition to make arrangements for the safety of men and material brought to the site.

Clause 12: Adjudication of Dispute and differences:

Except where otherwise provided in the contract all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the specifications, designs drawings and instruction herein before mentioned and as to the quality of workmanship or materials used on the work or as to any way arising out of or relating to the contract designs, drawings specifications ,estimates ,instruction orders or these conditions or otherwise concerning the works or the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment there of shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the person appointed by the Exhibition authority.

The contractor shall not question the nomination of the arbitration on the ground that the Exhibition authority nominated the said arbitrator.
